

Program Discriptions

Cow Poke

Designed for ages 4-7 and their parent. These horse lovers learn safety around horses, approaching, leading grooming and basic riding skills. Classes will begin un-mounted and then progress to mounted. 30 minute horse activities with 15 minute group devotionals. Adult (person over 18 years of age) participation is required at each lesson.

Bible & Bridle

Ages from 8-Adult will enjoy these 1-hour horsemanship classes, followed by 1/2 hour fellowship activity. *English, Western, Jumping, Vaulting, Gaming or Trail Riding* are a few of the skills you may choose to concentrate on. New Riders will always start with an un-mounted class and then progress to mounted.

Home School Program for PE Credit

Riding Skills, Horse Science and Fellowship activities in a 2-hour time block.

Recreational Therapeutic Riding

For youth to adults with disabilities : both physical and cognitive. Horse activity customized for each rider in a 1 hour time block. Qualified instructors and assistants will offer lots of safe fun and beneficial riding skills and exercises.

Jr. Wranglers

For those horse crazy 9 to 12 year old kids who can't get enough. Enrolled in Bible & Bridle is required. This is an extra hour of ground horsemanship management before or after each scheduled riding lesson

Practice Rides

For students who would like extra time practicing riding skills. Supervised by an instructor, no formal instruction, rider grooms and tacks up their horse .

Fun Days

For currently enrolled riders. Riders sign up to compete against other enrolled riders in gaming events and horse games. This is a great way to practice skills and gain confidence while having fun and winning prizes.

Ground School and Training

Ground school is time spent working with horses on the ground, not mounted. Learn how to catch any horse, round pen techniques, and how to teach horse proper ground manners using natural horsemanship principles.

Trail Rides

Bring your family or group. Take a quick basic riding lesson in the arena and then hit some of 300 acres of trails RRR has to offer. Relax and enjoy the ride.
