Dear Camper and Family,

We are very excited that you will be attending Royal Ridges Retreat! Here is some important information to help with the check-in process and a list of items to bring/have for your stay.

Camp Store: The Camp Store will accept cash or Camp Store Cards for purchases. Campers are allowed to carry their own money, however, Camp Store Cards are highly recommended. RRR is not responsible for any cash in the possession of Campers. We suggest \$10 but not more than \$15 store cards. REMEMBER: unspent store card balances ARE NOT refunded. Balances will go directly to the Camp Scholarship Fund at the end of each week. No carry-over balances.

DO NOT BRING: cell phones, i-pods, mp3 players, pagers, radios, CDs, tape players, computer games, inappropriate reading material! (Parents, please honor our cell phone rule.)

Lost and Found: PLEASE check the Lost and Found before leaving camp.

Map to RRR: Directions to RRR are posted on our web site www.royalridges.org. We encourage you to use these directions. (Found under MAPS)

Sunday – Everyone Come!!! 4:00 – 5:30 pm (please DO NOT arrive prior to 4:00!)

This is the time to arrive, finish paperwork, talk with the Nurse, if needed, purchase your RRR shirt and/or Store Card, and get your bus/carpool bracelet! Camp begins Monday.
